Pathways Beyond High School Working Group Strategies

1. Provide youth and their caregivers access to information about post-secondary opportunities including but not limited to 2-year, 4-year, vocational training, and work readiness programs.
2. Create opportunities for youth and young adults to identify career interests, establish personal goals, and begin preparing for future success (i.e. local career and college fairs, workshops on preparing for your future, career and skill assessment opportunities).
3. Develop and implement the summer ServiceCorps Summer Youth Employment and Leadership Development Program which helps youth develop job skills, leadership skills, and value of community involvement.

Role of the Pathways Beyond High School Working Group:

In coordination with the Coatesville Area School District and other local educational entities, this workgroup provides information about post-secondary opportunities and seeks to increase participation of youth and their families in workshops and trainings.
